The Director of Financial Empowerment has operational and service delivery responsibility for all recruiting and programmatic programming efforts supporting the League's workforce development initiatives. Reporting to the Executive Director of the Miami Valley Urban League, this role will implement the strategic direction for financial empowerment programs, including leading the SOAR and EMERGE teams and fostering long-term business partnerships for growth. A successful candidate must know industry standards and best practices to execute our programs for our participants. The individual must be resourceful, communicative, and results-driven.

What You'll Do:

- Oversee and implement workforce development programs that align with organizational goals.
- Manage day-to-day operations of workforce programming, ensuring efficiency and impact.
- Oversee job fairs, career readiness workshops, and training programs for participants.
- Build and maintain relationships with employers, training providers, and community partners to expand workforce opportunities.
- Manage budget management and assist in monitoring program expenditures to align with funding requirements.
- Utilize Microsoft Office and CRM systems to track participant progress, manage data, and generate reports.
- Prepare and submit grant reports to ensure compliance with funding requirements.
- Assist in marketing workforce programs by working with the communications team to enhance visibility and outreach.
